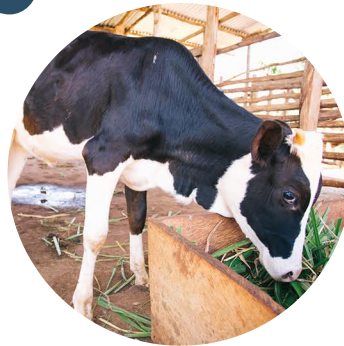

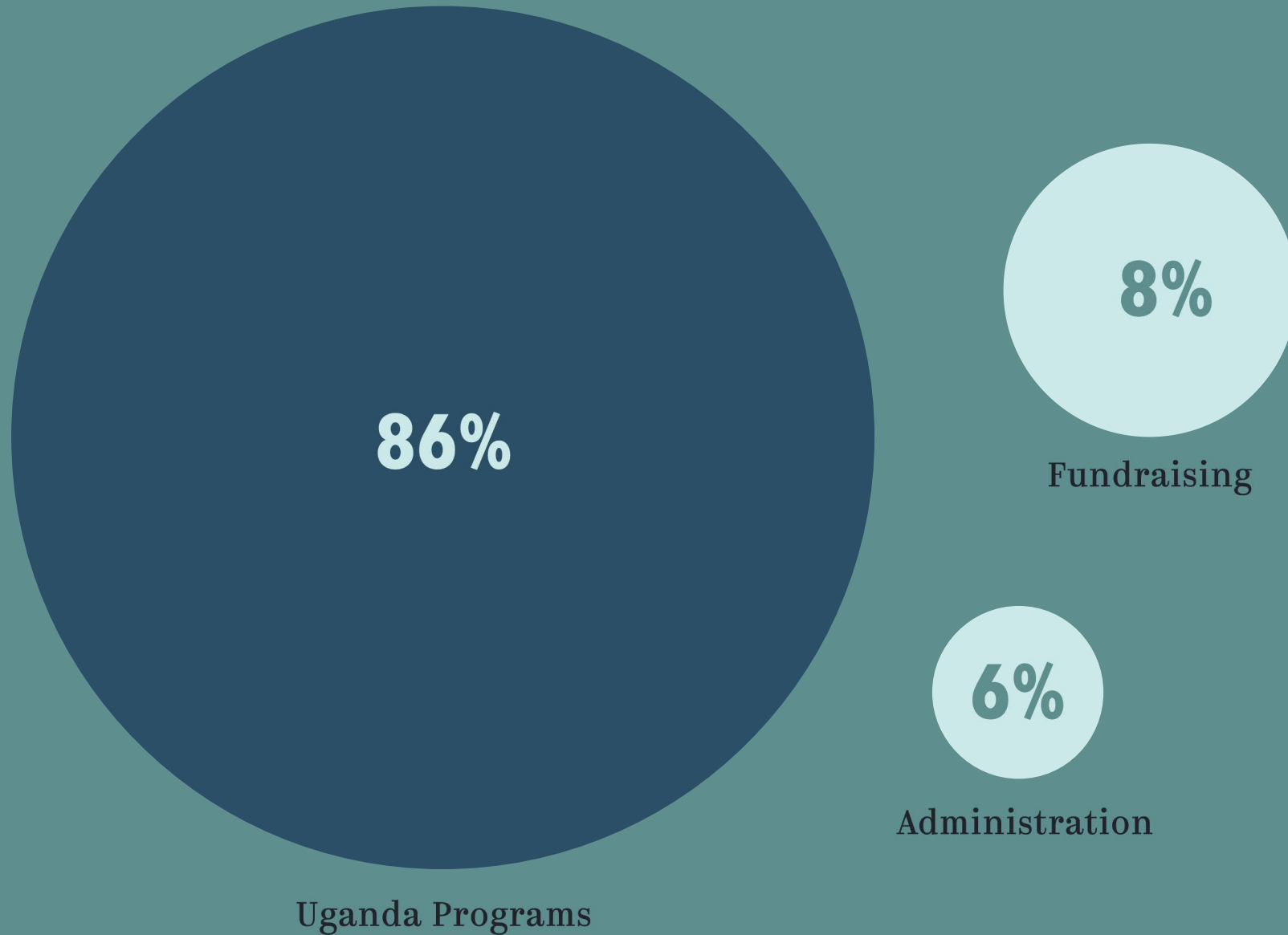

# HOW YOUR MONEY WAS SPENT

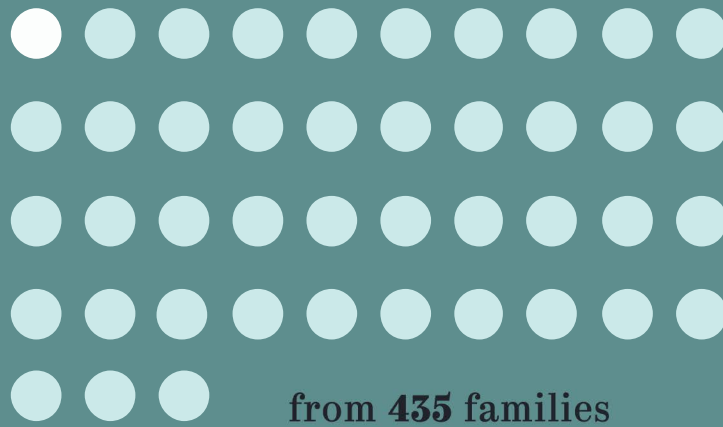

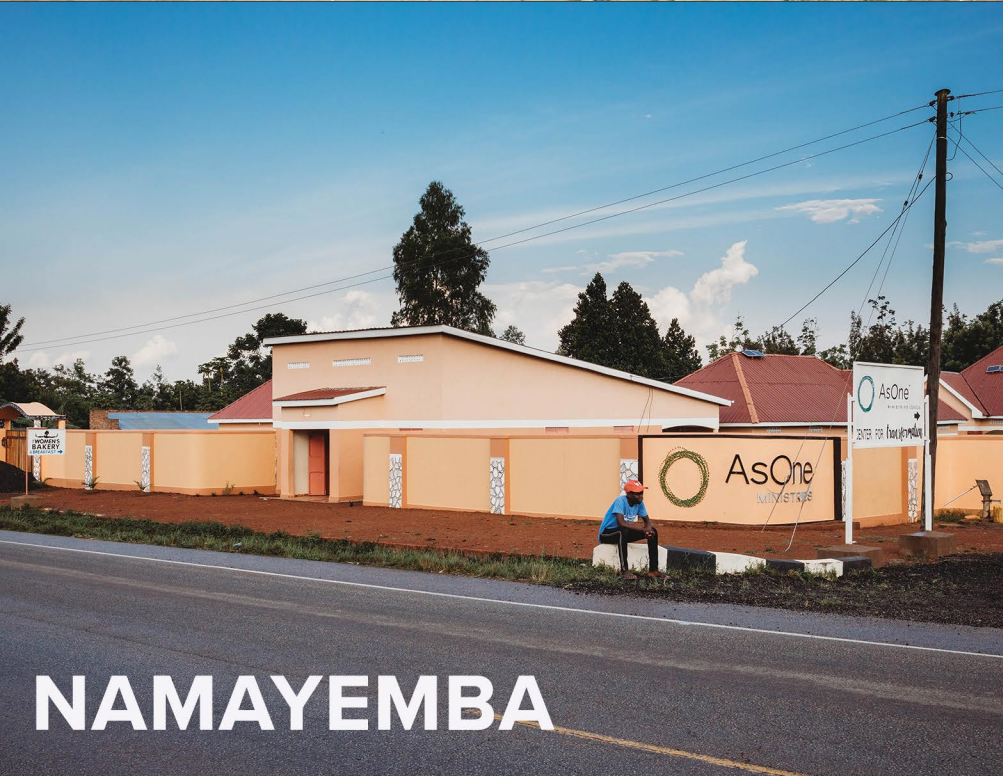

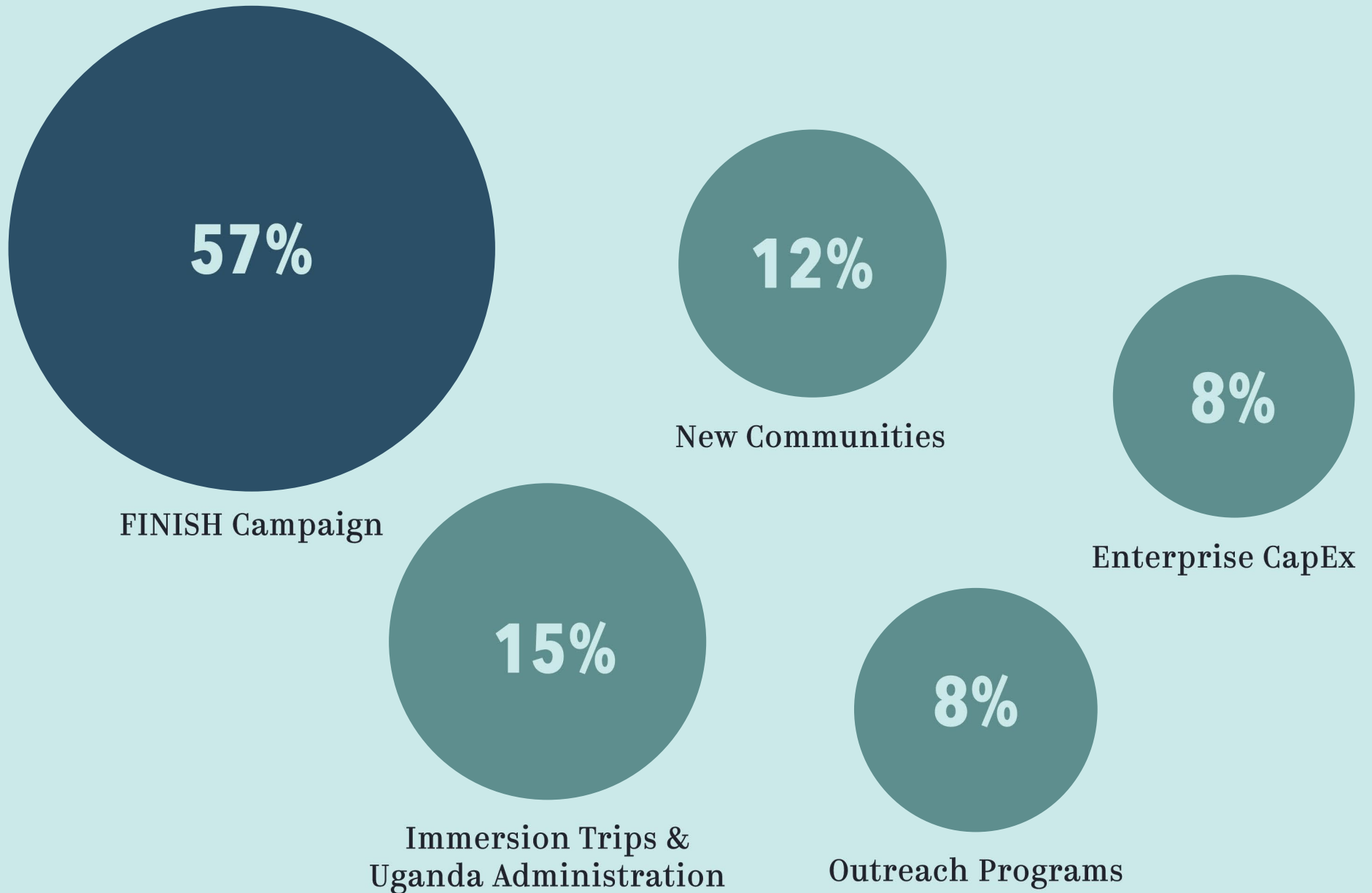

A breakdown of our Uganda program expenditures

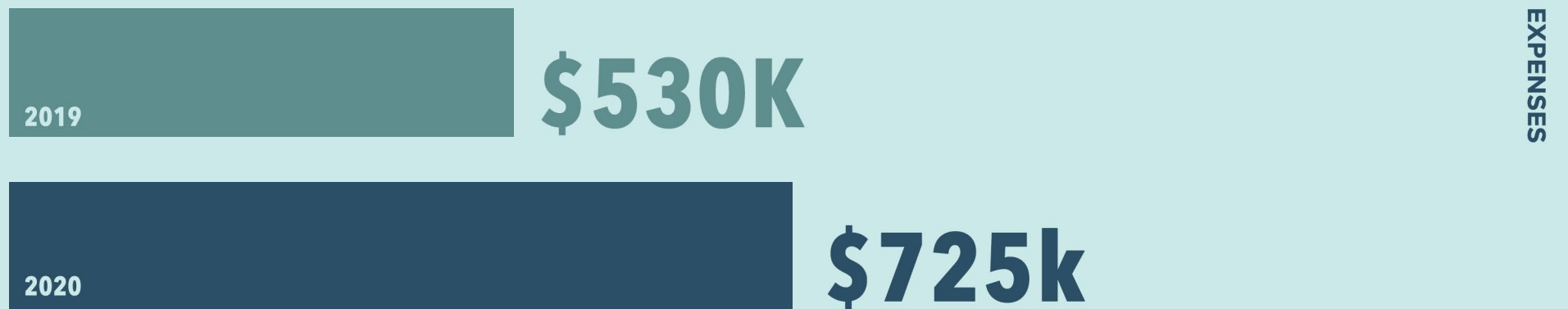

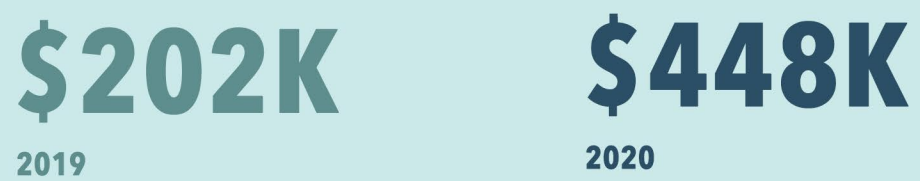
Consolidated Schedule of Activity
